Join our Sea of Fish to embed Torres Strait Islander perspectives into your practice during NAIDOC Week Sunday 2nd July to Sunday 9th July. Come celebrate our Elders - our Old People that have paved the way for us and that continue to show us the way.

WHAT DO WE DO?

Step 1

Print out the Torres Strait Island EASY WEAVING FISH instruction sheet provided, to show Educators, Children, families and Community how to Weave a Fish from the Torres Strait Islands or get creative and Make your own Fish.

Step 2

Ask everyone, children, all families, educators and their families, community members and their families to Weave a Fish or Make a Fish.

Step 3

Decorate the Fish, place the Fish onto sticks or string to create your Sea of Fish. Make sure you include ALL Fish, put them where they are visible for all to see. You can hang them or stake them in the ground, however you want to display them.

Step 4

Take PHOTOS of your Sea of Fish POST them onto your Facebook page, POST them onto Connecting the Dots through Culture Facebook pages during National NAIDOC Week with the Hashtags:
